





BUMP non-Cruise What is it?

<u>First, a "non-Event"</u> is a way to raise funds with less stress on everyone. It grows from the idea that doing fundraisers which bring in the neighborhood involves TONS of hours in work and outreach and often don't raise that much money. When we look at the net income we might remark, "It would be easier to just donate the money ourselves." With a "non-event," (in this case a "non-cruise,") we donate funds <u>but do NOT actually go on a cruise!</u> HOWEVER, since we enjoy having meals together, we WILL have "The Captain's Dinner," which is a cruise ship tradition of a formal-attire, sit-down meal and the fun of a Silent Action.



<u>Then, BUMP</u> is this congregation's way of encouraging each member of the congregation to increase their financial giving to support our ministries funded through the general budget. When we BUMP up our giving, we acknowledge that through our efforts GOD makes possible far more than we imagine!

2012 was our first year of BUMP giving - allowing us to pay all our bills AND 100% of our apportionments for the first time in nearly two decades. In 2013 we did not have a BUMP for the budget.
