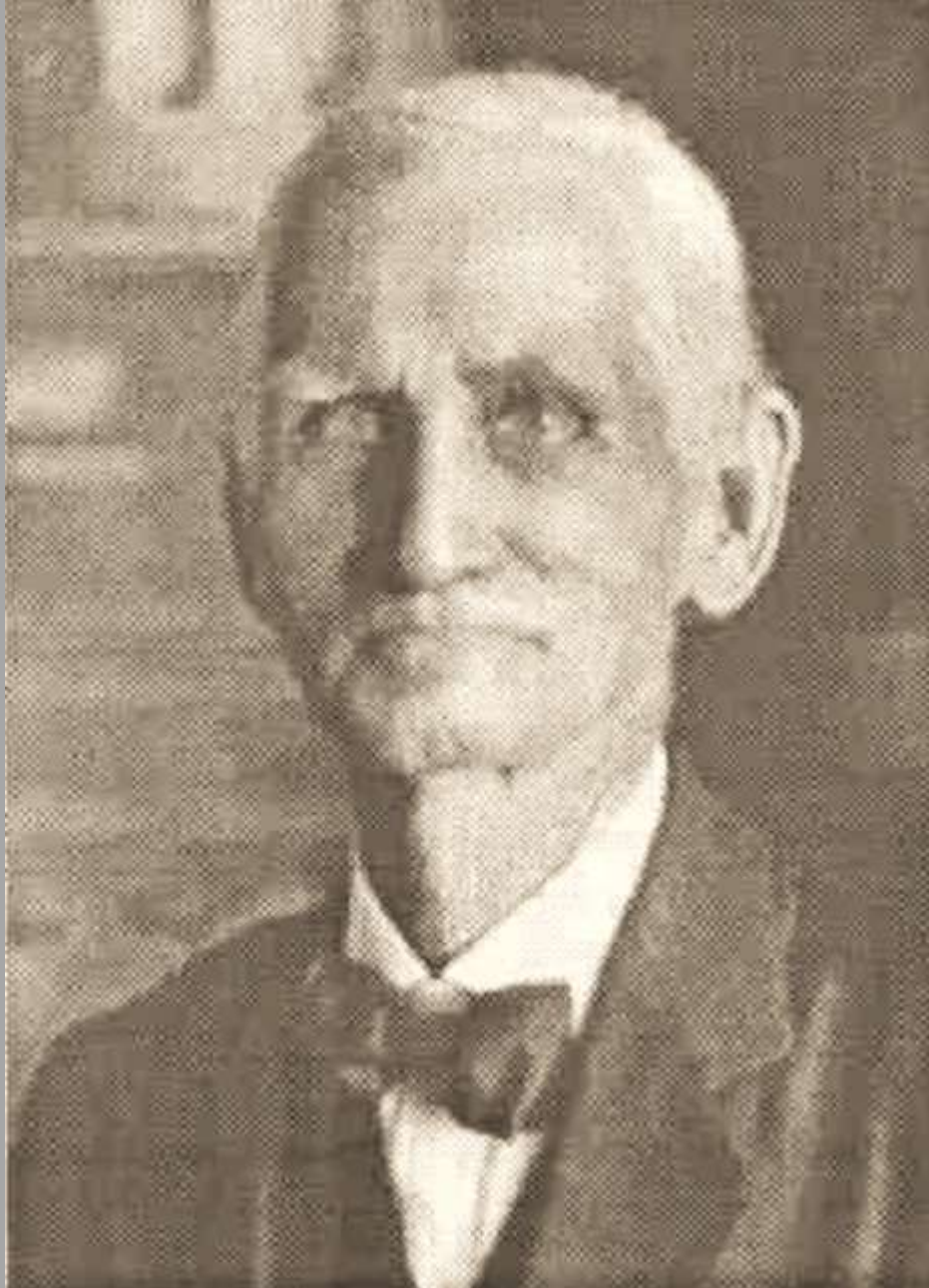

Clovis California March 24, 1898

Secretary, Sister Harper, being absent. Corresponding Secretary Sister Gray, acted as Recording Secretary. Services opened by singing No 93.

"Standing on the promises," Prayer by Sister Mullins. The subject for raising finances was thoroughly discussed.

It was regularly moved and seconded, that we adopt as the motto of our Society, the 14 verse of the 19 Psalm, which is as follows. Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in Thy sight, O Lord, my strength and my Redeemer. - Carried -

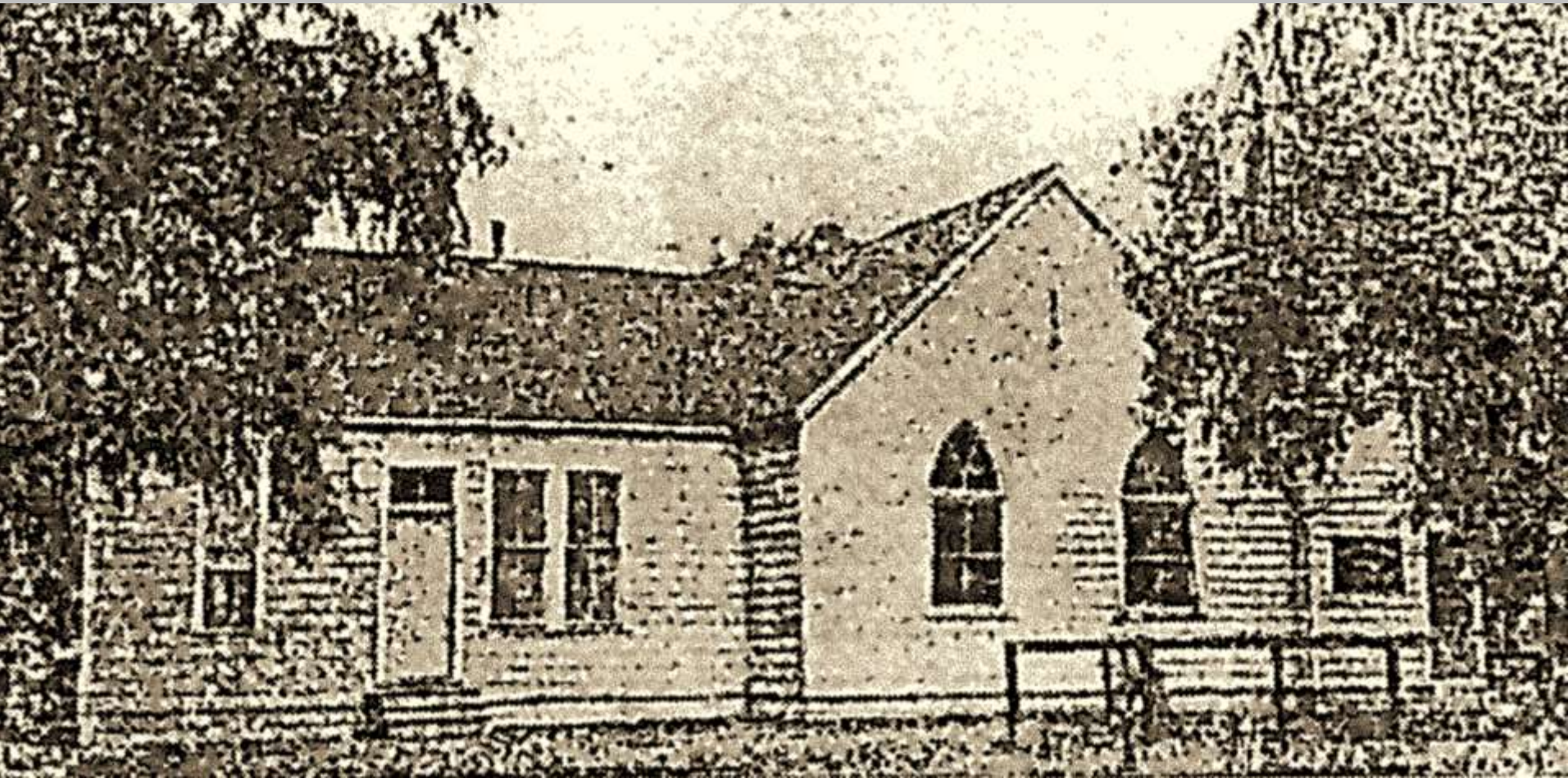
The names of Mrs. Smith, and Miss M. Oliphant were proposed for membership.

The hour set for meeting, was then decided, to be at 2:30 P. M. each Thursday.

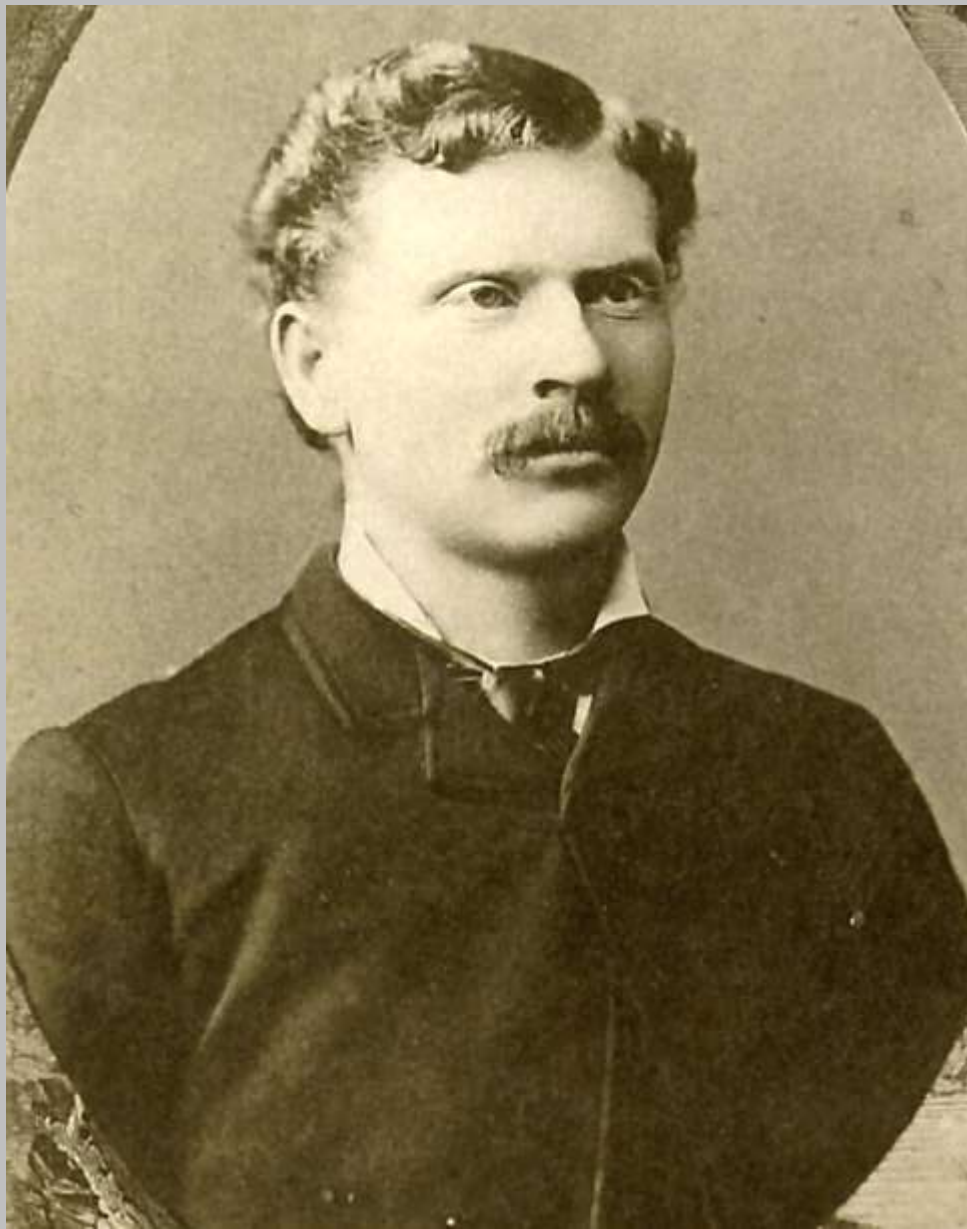

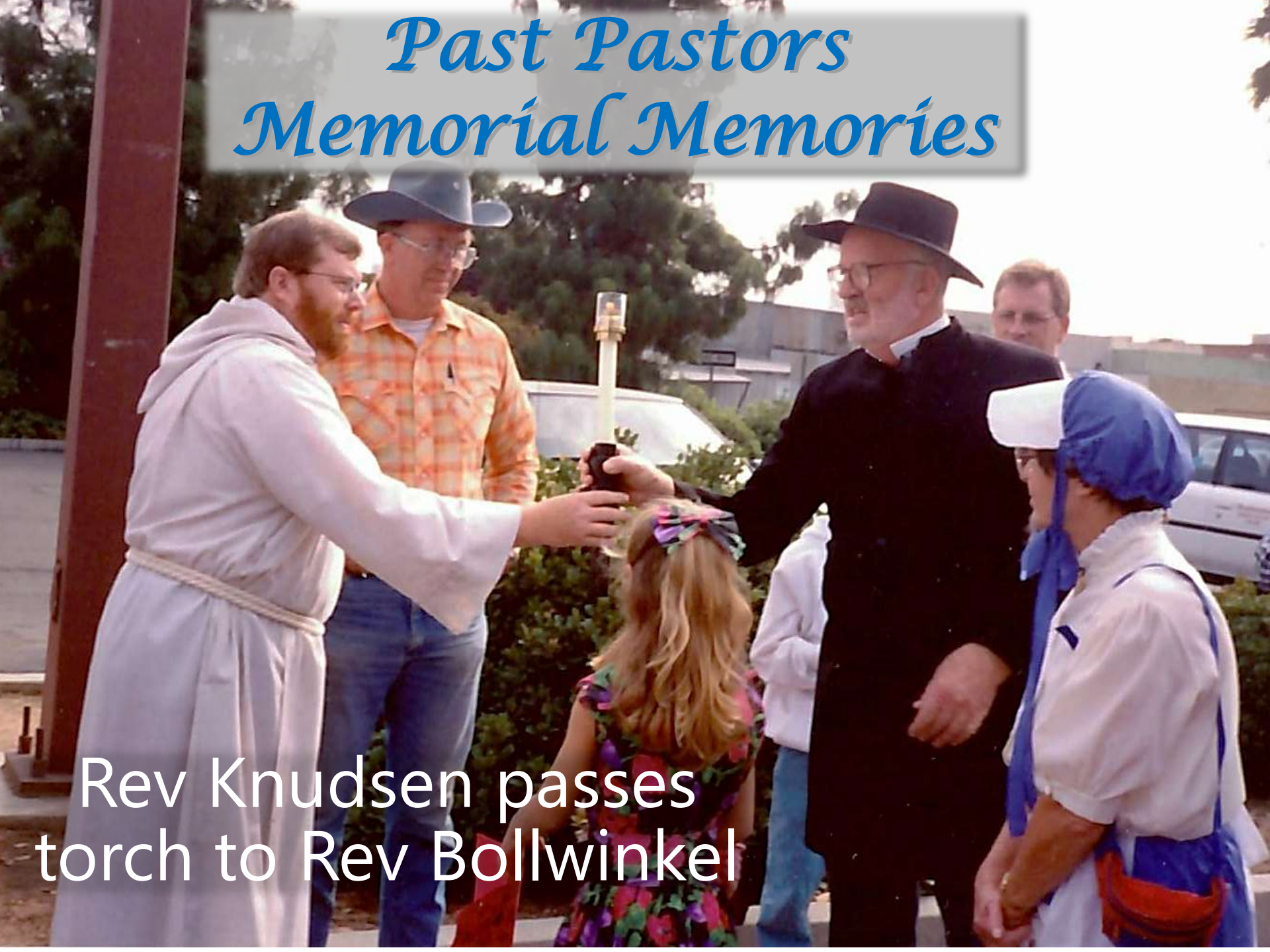

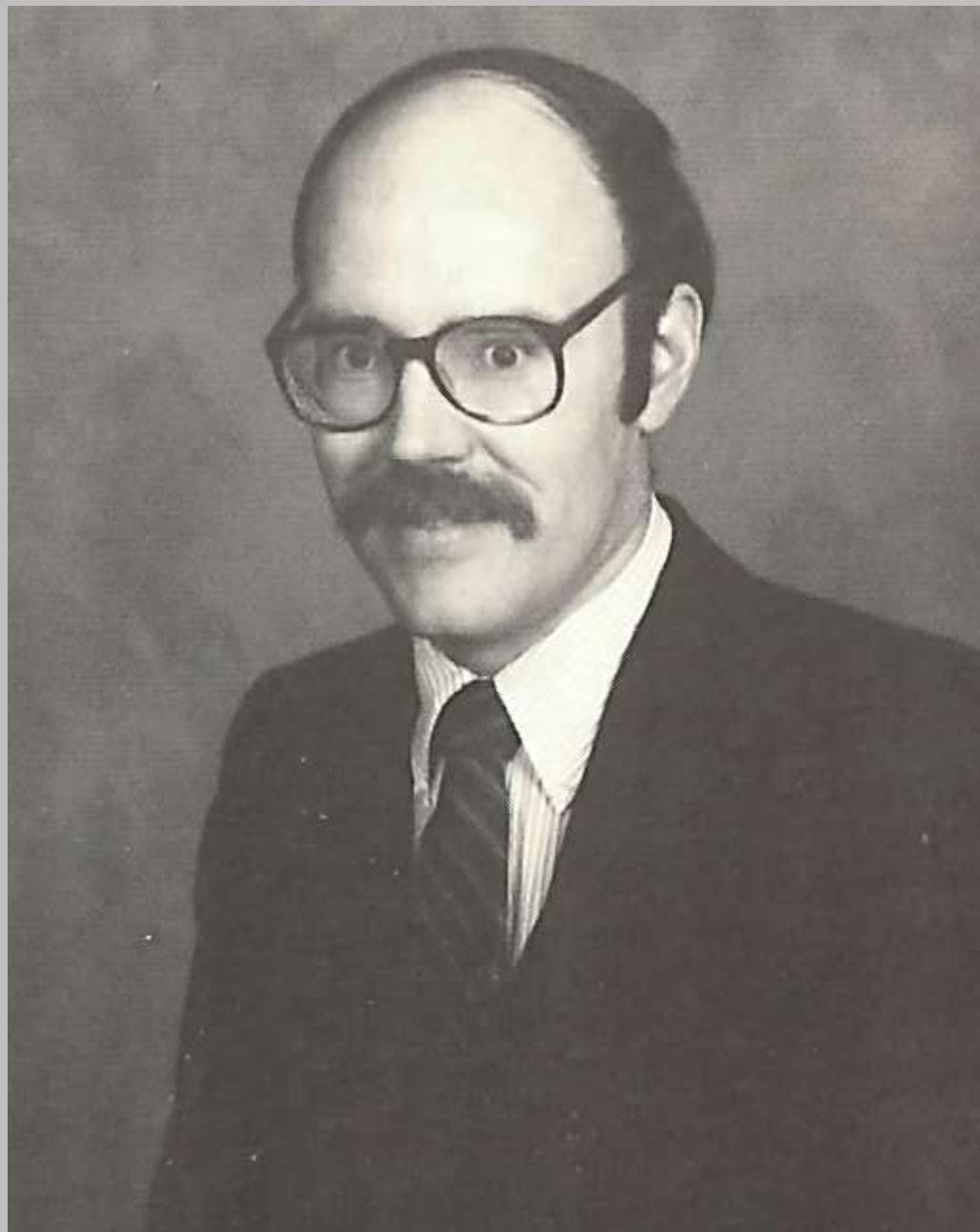
